## Lesson #3



### Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

### Objective:

- Students will recognize basic patterns of language by using visual aids from a work of literature to connect an object to its description.

### Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Colors, Markers, or Color Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Kacklin' Kitchen*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form with the list of images and descriptions. Have the students draw a line from the object to its correct name.

### Assessment:

Students will learn to recognize and identify objects by using their developmental-level vocabulary in reading.
