

# The Kacklin' Kitchen

## Lesson #5



### Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

### Objective:

- Students will utilize directional words to determine the relative location of objects.

### Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Colors, Markers, or Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Kacklin' Kitchen*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will review the positions of left, right, and middle. Ask the students to find the object and place an X on the box. Then students will determine which directional position the object is in.

### Assessment:

Students will increase their understanding of positional orientation, providing a greater perspective in relation to every day uses.
