Objective:

- Students will use listening strategies effectively.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Ocean Commotion, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students discuss the story and its message. Then hand out the form in which students will recall the sequence of events in the order in which they occurred.

Assessment:

Students will construct meaning from the text, determine the author's purpose, and identify relevant supporting facts. They will utilize their listening and speaking skills to successfully discuss the details of the text, and arrange the events of the story in chronological order.
