Age: 4th Grade

Objective:

- Students will understand the effects on numbers and the relationships among these operations.
- Students will select appropriate operations and compute for problem solving.

Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Ocean Commotion, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students solve the addition and subtraction equations created for this activity.

Assessment:

Students recognize the effects of addition and subtraction on whole numbers. They'll identify the appropriate operation to solve specific problems including mental mathematics, paper and pencil, and calculators.
