- 2. What was his assistant's name? Thomas Watson
- 3. On what date was the patent issued for the telephone? March 7, 1876
- 4. Wooden wall telephones like the one seen above were created from 1876 1900, and came equipped with a hand crank. What was the crank used for?

When turned, it produced a ring which alerted the operator that you wanted to make a call.

5. Over the years, many telephones have been produced. Name three different styles of telephone that have been seen over the years.
