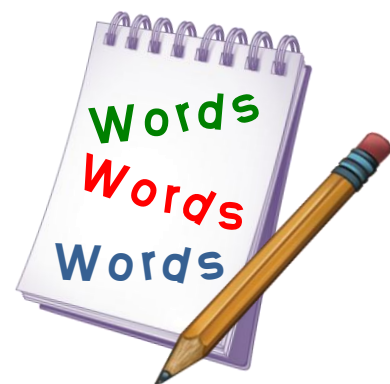


Ocean Commotion

Lesson #3



Age:
Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will use writing processes effectively by recognizing and practicing correct spellings of SIGHT WORDS.
- Students will increase comprehension of SIGHT WORDS, by reading them aloud.

Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik

Pencils

Printed out form attached that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *Ocean Commotion*, showing the illustrations to all of the students. After the reading, hand out the form that provides different words used in the book. Ask the students to write out the word on their own, and then read each word aloud.

Assessment:

Students increase their comprehension of sight words by writing and rereading them aloud. They will identify word structure and increase their developmental-level vocabulary.
