Lesson #3



Behavioral Issue:

Does not comprehend what he/she reads

Objective:

- Students will learn to identify main points in the material.
- Students will improve their reading comprehension skills.

Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik

Pen or Pencil

Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

Activity:

Have the student or students who are participating in this activity read Ocean Commotion to themselves. Then ask them to read it again, having them write a sentence for each page, describing what they think each page means. If after this exercise, you feel they're still unable to comprehend the story, you may want to go over the material again, either together or with a student tutor. The Lilly the Lash series offers inexpensive DVDs of the storybooks. Viewing the DVD while following along with the book will increase comprehension.

Assessment:

Students will gain a true comprehension of what they have read. They'll recognize the perspective and be equipped to offer their opinion, providing a sense of pride and accomplishment.
