Lesson #4



Behavioral Issue:

Doesn't accept responsibility for his/her actions

Objective:

- Students will understand the harmful results of not taking responsibility for their actions.
- Students will learn to take responsibility for their actions.

Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik Pen or Pencil Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

Activity:

Gather the students in a circle and read Ocean Commotion, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, discuss the happenings in the book and the lesson learned. Now have the students read and answer the questions proposed on the form. Have them try to imagine being the characters and feel the feelings each of them may have had. Afterwards discuss all of the questions...especially the last one.

Assessment:

Students will become aware of the importance of admitting a wrongdoing. They'll recognize how their actions affect others, and will learn affective ways to stand up and set things straight - leaving them with a sense of pride!
