Age:

1st Grade

Objective:

- Students will apply knowledge about life processes to distinguish between living and non-living things.

Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik

Pencils, Pens, or Markers

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Ocean Commotion.

After the reading, hand out the form in which students will determine the living object in each row, and answer the science questions regarding living creatures.

Assessment:

Students will utilize their knowledge to recognize and separate living from non-living things. They will review functions of living things, as well as the environments they live in.
