
Ocean Commotion

Lesson #1



Age: Pre-Kindergarten

Objective:

• Students will use their personal perspective in responding to a work of literature, and recognize that people see things in different ways.

Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik Colors. Markers. or Color Pencils Print out form that correlates with this lesson. Optional – Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached *Letter for Parents*

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Ocean Commotion, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the line art form of Echo. Have the students color her the way they would like her to look.

Assessment:

Students recognize their personal perspective by coloring the character as they would like her to appear.
