

# Ocean Commotion

## Lesson #1



### Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

### Objective:

- Students will use their personal perspective in responding to a work of literature, and recognize that people see things in different ways.

### Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik

Colors, Markers, or Color Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *Ocean Commotion*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the line art form of Echo. Have the students color her the way they would like her to look.

### Assessment:

Students recognize their personal perspective by coloring the character as they would like her to appear.
