Lesson #2



Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will identify and compare two dimensional shapes.
- Students will recognize simple patterns and duplicate them.

Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik

Colors, Markers, or Colored Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *Ocean Commotion*, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will color the shape in the lower section, identical to the example given in the section above. Then ask them to identify each shape.

Assessment:

Students will become familiar with two dimensional shapes, and will successfully compare and duplicate patterns.
