# Age:

# Objective:

• Students will analyze and identify measurable attributes to determine differences in objects similar in appearance.

#### Materials:

Ocean Commotion by Julie Woik Colors, Markers, or Colored Pencils Print out form attached that correlates with this lesson. Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached Letter for Parents

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Ocean Commotion, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will circle the biggest item in each row. Afterwards discuss the lesson of honesty from the book, and encourage the students to stand tall and be the "biggest" when it comes to telling the truth about something that may happen to or around them.

### Assessment:

Students understand the significance of measurement in regard to describing objects according to a single attribute.
