

Lilly the Lash

Girl Scout Patch Program - Option 2

"MY Lilly the Lash"



Age Level:
Brownies

Group Size:
1 to 30

Materials:

The Garden Gathering book by Julie Woik

1 White 24" h x 36" w Poster board (optional)

Letter size colored construction paper (Heavier stock is ideal)

1 Eyelash Template (included)

2 Lilly the Lash Templates (included)

Girl Scout to bring: Head shot of either face on or profile about 1" in size

Glitter

Scissors and glue

Discover:

Read The Garden Gathering together as a group. Afterwards, discuss how Sunny felt about herself and why that affected her attitude. Discover the importance of having a positive self-image.

Connect:

- Each girl will cut out an eyelash using the template (any color).
- Each girl will cut out the Lilly the Lash template of her choice.
- Place the Lilly the Lash template onto the eyelash and glue down.
- Cut and glue the scout's head in the space provided.
- Glue and sprinkle a bit of glitter onto the eyelash.
- Optional: The troop leader can make a large eye (without lashes) on the poster board and name it OUR Lovely Lillys or The Lovely Lashes of Troop 000 (there is an eye reference on Lilly's website).
- If you are going to use the poster board idea, glue the lashes onto the eye and display. Otherwise the Girl Scout can take her lash home.

Take Action:

Have the girls sit in a circle. Ask each Girl Scout to give an example of a quality she has that makes her feel good about herself and describe why. Example: I do very well in math. I get good grades, and that allows me to help others who have trouble with it. Being helpful makes me feel great!
