Girl Scout Patch Program - Option 3

"Make Your Mark"



Age Level:

Daisies

Group Size:

1 to 30

Materials:

The Toy Store book by Julie Woik

Pencils, Pens, or Markers

Print the Template for this activity on letter size white paper

(heavier stock is preferred) - one print out for each Girl Scout

Tempera Paints - paint most often used for finger painting

Frames - plain inexpensive letter size frames

Discover:

Read The Toy Store together. Afterwards, discuss the importance of sharing with others. Talk about how Tommy felt sad inside without friends, but he didn't know how to make them. Discover how Aaron's attitude toward Tommy made a difference and helped Tommy to see that being part of something bigger than himself is what life is all about!

Connect:

- Each Girl Scout will receive one printed template to fill out.
 - * In statement three, answers can range from little to big:
Helping my neighbor, picking up litter, recycling, donating pocket change to people in need around the world.
- Using the paints, each girl will place her hand print on the globe
- After the paint is fully dry, place the activity in a frame.

Take Action:

After clean up, gather everyone in a circle. Give each of the girls a moment to talk about her feelings regarding making the world a better place. When we SHARE our love for mankind, we create friendships and everyone around us benefits. Be part of it TODAY!!
