The Little Building Lesson #2



Age: 2nd Grade

Objective:

- Students will use their personal perspective to respond critically to a fictional work of literature.
- Students will write to communicate ideas effectively.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates to this lesson. Students will get a chance to voice their honest opinions to the author regarding the seventh book in the series.

Assessment:

Students will form their own ideas and opinions about what has been read in a literary text, and use specific information from the text to support these ideas. They'll write comments and observations that reflect comprehension of content.
