The Little Building Lesson #3



Age: 2nd Grade

Objective:

- Students will use listening strategies effectively.
- Students will strengthen their memory skills by successfully recalling details from a work of literature.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik Pencils or Pens Print out form that correlates with this lesson. Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson. See attached *Letter for Parents*

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students discuss the story, rereading the story a couple of time if necessary. Then hand out the form in which students will provide what they recall about the characters in this wonderful story about responsibility.

Assessment:

Students will use their listening skills to determine what is happening in a storybook. They will take an interest in the illustrations, and notice details that make the story fun and interesting, providing a memorable experience.
