## Lesson #4



**Age:**  
2<sup>nd</sup> Grade

### Objective:

- Students will read and organize information to perform a specific task.
- Students will understand the effects of simple operations on numbers and the relationships among these operations.

### Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Little Building*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates to this lesson. Have the students read each puzzle and figure out the correct answer.

### Assessment:

Students use reading and organizing information to recognize the effects of simple operations. They practice a more sophisticated approach to addition and subtraction and begin to understand the patterns leading to the next step in mathematics.
