The Little Building Lesson #4



Age: 2nd Grade

Objective:

- Students will read and organize information to perform a specific task.
- Students will understand the effects of simple operations on numbers and the relationships among these operations.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates to this lesson. Have the students read each puzzle and figure out the correct answer.

Assessment:

Students use reading and organizing information to recognize the effects of simple operations. They practice a more sophisticated approach to addition and subtraction and begin to understand the patterns leading to the next step in mathematics.
