The Little Building Lesson #1

Age: 4th Grade



Objective:

- Students will evaluate and discuss events and information about the text.
- Students will apply and extend these ideas to their own real-life situations.
- Students will offer their opinions regarding the subject line.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, have a discussion regarding Boomer's chat with Professor Wilma Wiseowl. Then hand out the form that correlates to this lesson. Ask the students to use their own perspective and experiences to answer the questions.

Assessment:

Students will recall information from the text and use their personal experiences to relate. Students will understand why the author of the book felt it was important to have one character talk to another to seek a solution to their problem.
