The Little Building Lesson #3



Age: $4^{\rm th}$ Grade

Objective:

- Students will use the reading process effectively to identify words and construct meaning from the text.
- Students will write to identify a central idea and comprehend the author's purpose in writing.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the illustrations. You may choose to read this story several times to the class, or have them read it themselves. Once you feel the students have a pretty good understanding of the story, have the children fill out the form that corresponds with this lesson. Afterwards, have a class discussion to assure that everyone comprehends the importance of being responsible.

Assessment:

Students will determine the main concept of the author's literary work. They'll understand the development of the plot and how conflicts are resolved in a story, and in real-life situations.
