

The Little Building

Lesson #3



Age:
4th Grade

Objective:

- Students will use the reading process effectively to identify words and construct meaning from the text.
- Students will write to identify a central idea and comprehend the author's purpose in writing.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Little Building*, showing everyone the illustrations. You may choose to read this story several times to the class, or have them read it themselves. Once you feel the students have a pretty good understanding of the story, have the children fill out the form that corresponds with this lesson. Afterwards, have a class discussion to assure that everyone comprehends the importance of being responsible.

Assessment:

Students will determine the main concept of the author's literary work. They'll understand the development of the plot and how conflicts are resolved in a story, and in real-life situations.
