## Lesson #3



"IT'S UP TO YOU!"

**Age:**  
5<sup>th</sup> Grade

### Objective:

- Students will develop an understanding of the concept of responsibility through an established commitment.
- Students will identify the various ways in which they demonstrate responsibility.

### Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Pencils

Print and cut out the slip (for each student) for this lesson.

Print the DETAILS list for the adult to keep track of everything.

Each student will bring what they are responsible for.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Little Building*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, discuss the importance of responsibility, and following through with your commitment to make sure no one is let down. Get everyone excited about a party you're going to have!! Explain that everyone will be responsible for a task regarding the party. Give each person a task. Make the party the BEST party EVER!!!!

### Assessment:

Students will understand that responsibility isn't just doing chores (personal responsibilities like homework or household chores), it's following through on commitments, answering for their own actions, being reliable, and not procrastinating.
