The Little Building Lesson #4



Age: 5th Grade

Objective:

- Students will define responsibility and dependability.
- Students will understand the importance of being responsible and dependable in various aspects of their lives.
- Students will express their understanding of dependability through a poster.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik
Show sample poster to the students for reference
Poster boards, markers, colored pencils, crayons, paint, glue,
scissors, magazines or printed images for collage choices
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, discuss the importance of responsibility, and following through with your commitment to make sure no one is let down. Then have the students create posters expressing their view of responsibility, dependability, and accountability. Place the posters around the classroom or on the walls of the school. Make a statement!!!

Assessment:
