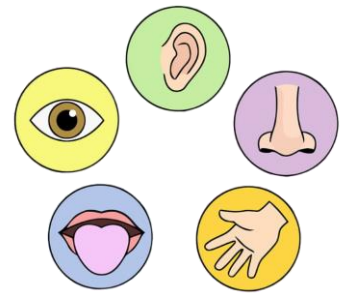


The Little Building

Lesson #3



Age:
Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will look for and identify basic body parts (eyes, ears, nose, mouth, hands) of different objects.
- Students will understand that the five senses are shared by many different kinds of animals.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Pencils, Colors, Markers, or Color Pencils

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Little Building*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, review the different characters in the story, and have the students identify and describe each of the senses. Hand out the form that goes with this activity. Have the students put an X on all of the objects that have 5 senses.

Assessment:

Students will gain a better understanding of sight, hearing, smell, taste, and touch. They'll easily be able to point out the different senses and how each of them affect our daily lives.
