## Lesson #3



**Age:**  
Pre-Kindergarten

### **Objective:**

- Students will engage in an interactive and personal way to learn all about themselves
- Students will share their likes and dislikes, to help them recognize how we all are different and yet unique in our own way.

### **Materials:**

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Pencils, Colors, Markers, or Colored Pencils

### **Activity:**

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Little Building*, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will provide their personal information. Afterwards, discuss how each of the characters in the book were different, had different jobs, and yet worked together as a team.

### **Assessment:**

Students will build quality relationships with other students through the sharing of personal information, and create a sense of belonging amongst each other.
