
The Little Building

Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will be able to match items that are the same or are different from the others.
- Students will learn to sort and organize information into similar groups.

Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik
Pencils, Colors, Markers, or Colored Pencils
Print out form attached that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Little Building, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will mark the matches. Afterwards, discuss how Rita Rat Tootles tried to help everyone be organized. She took responsibility for getting each character to do a specific job. That's AWESOME!!

Assessment:

Students used their memory to identify patterns and relationships and similarity and difference. This helps children learn about problem solving. Matching and sorting activities can also be good for developing fine motor skills.
