

# The Little Building

## Lesson #5



### Age:

Pre-Kindergarten

### Objective:

- Students will analyze and identify measurable attributes to determine differences in objects similar in appearance.

### Materials:

The Little Building by Julie Woik

Pencils, Colors, Markers, or Colored Pencils

Print out form attached that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

### Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Little Building*, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form in which students will circle the biggest item in each section. Afterwards discuss the lesson of responsibility from the book, and encourage the students to stand tall and be the “biggest” when it comes to being reliable and dependable when they make a commitment.

### Assessment:

Students understand the significance of measurement in regard to describing objects according to a single attribute.
