The Toy Store Lesson #4



Age:

3rd Grade

Objective:

• Students will measure quantities in the real world and use the measures to problem solve.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, discuss Tommy's unacceptable behavior, although he had access to all of the toys in the store. Remind the students that money and "things" can't buy happiness! Then hand out the form that correlates with this lesson. Have the students utilize their knowledge of monetary value to solve the problems.

Assessment:

Students will select and use appropriate units of measurement to achieve the degree of precision required in a real-world situation.
