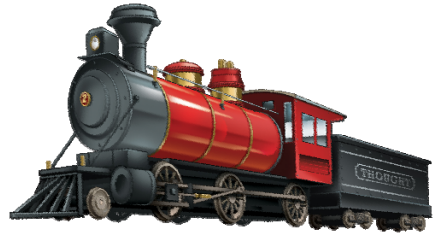


The Toy Store

Lesson #3

Age:
4th Grade



Objective:

- Students will use simple strategies such as word structure, context clues, and self-questioning to identify words and construct meaning.
- Students will increase knowledge of vocabulary by reviewing and recalling correct spellings.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates to this lesson. Have a discussion about the moral of the story. Students define the words from The Toy Store and then find them in the puzzle.

NOTE: The number in parentheses depicts the amount of times the word can be found in the puzzle.

Assessment:

Students increase knowledge of vocabulary by defining words, reviewing and recalling the correct spellings, and finding them in the word search activity.
