Capacity	O	A polygon with 8 sides and 8 angles.

Equivalent	Y	A unit of length equaling 36 inches.
Fraction	B	A way to show information that uses bars to stand for data.
Grid	K	A metric unit that is used to measure mass.
Hour Hand	V	The measure of the space a solid figure occupies.
Impossible	A	The process of finding the total number of items when two groups are joined.
Julie	D	Information collected about people or things.
Kilogram	U	Darkest part of a shadow.
Line of Symmetry	E	Two or more sets that name the same amount.
Mass	G	A map divided into equally spaced squares.
Numerator	Z	When adding zero to or subtracting zero from a number, the result is that number. When multiplying by zero, the result is zero. You can't divide by zero.
Octagon	C	The amount a container can hold when filled.
Parallel Lines	J	First name of the author to the Lilly the Lash series.
Quotient	I	Something that will never happen.
Remainder	M	The amount of matter in an object. Matter is what all objects are made of.
Sum	F	A number that names part of a whole or part of a group.
Tenth	H	The short hand on a clock.
Umbra	L	A line that divides a figure into two congruent parts.
Volume	R	The number that is left over after dividing.
Woik	Q	The answer in a division problem.
X Factor	P	Lines that never cross and are always the same distance apart.
Yard	T	One of ten equal parts.
Zero Property	X	An unknown quantity which becomes known only after following a prescribed process.
