The Toy Store Lesson #1



Age: 5th Grade

Objective:

- Students will write to communicate ideas effectively.
- Students will practice correct use of spelling, punctuation and capitalization.
- Students will use personal perspective in responding to a work of literature to increase comprehension of THEME.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, talk about decision making and how some of the children in the book responded differently to Tommy's behavior than others. Hand out the forms that correlate with this lesson. Have the students think about the scenario and decide what they would do and why. Discuss with the whole class.
