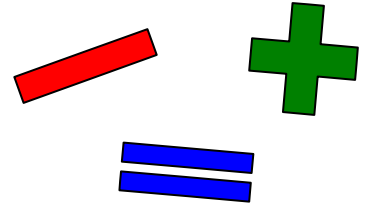


The Toy Store

Age:
5th Grade

Objective:

- Students will understand that numbers can be represented in a variety of equivalent forms.
- Students will select the appropriate operation to solve specific problems involving addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, hand out the form that correlates with this lesson. Ask the students to use their mathematic skills to solve these problems.

Assessment:

Students will learn to use methods of computing for problem solving such as mental mathematics, paper and pencil, and calculators.
