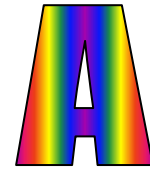


The Toy Store

Lesson #3

Age:
Pre-Kindergarten

Objective:

- Students will use listening and speaking strategies to follow directions and perform the task.
- Students will understand that word choices can shape ideas, feelings, and actions.
- Students will use movement and balance.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik

Large Letters from the Alphabet (Use all or just some)

Lay out letters on the floor in a path formation (See Example)

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

See attached *Letter for Parents*

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read *The Toy Store*, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, lay out the letters (not in order) on the floor around the room. Explain that one child at a time will walk the path of letters until you call out the word **SHARE!** The child will stop, announce the letter nearest to them, and give a word that begins with that letter. The word should be something people can SHARE.

Assessment:

Students will use knowledge of age appropriate developmental-level vocabulary to successfully play the game.
