The Toy Store Lesson #10



Behavioral Issue:

Does not raise hand appropriately

Objective:

• Students will raise their hands in an appropriate manner at the appropriate time.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik
Heavy stock - Letter size paper
Print 2 copies of each card group - (8 sheets for all 4 groups)
Scissors - Cut the cards out and mix them up

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, discuss the importance of sharing a classroom that works well together, pointing out that learning to raise their hand appropriately is key. After mixing up the cards, spread them out face down onto a table. This game is like Concentration. Each child takes a turn at flipping over two of the cards. They should read what the card says out loud. The object of the game is to find two cards that say the same thing. If they find a match, they put those two cards aside and take another turn. If not, return the cards to their same position and let someone else try.

Assessment:

Students will recognize and utilize the proper method for raising their hand.
