Lesson #1



Behavioral Issue:

Does Not Allow Others to Take Turns

Objective:

- Students will allow others to take turns.
- Students will allow others to participate in a game.
- Students will demonstrate appropriate interaction skills.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik

Scissors, Hat, Scrap Paper (to work out equation)

Pencils or Pens

Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

NOTE: Teacher will place the sentence with the letters, blanks, and numbers below, onto the board before start of game. Cut squares and place in a hat ready for the students to draw.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, point out that taking turns and having fun playing a game is part of sharing. Then students will take turns drawing a slip of paper with an equation and a picture from the book. The student must figure out the equation, then go to the board and place the first letter of the picture on the space or spaces that coordinate with their answer.

Assessment:

Students will learn appropriate ways to interact with peers in group settings by problem solving, taking turns, and following game rules.
