Choose students to dress up and act out the scenario

Scenario 1

Character One: A Doctor Character Two: A Businessman

Conflict: A doctor and a businessman are in line at a lunch buffet. The businessman is in a hurry, and cuts in front of the doctor to get his meal. The doctor becomes angry, pulls back the arm of the businessman, and yells very loudly in the restaurant, demanding that the businessman get back into line.

Scenario 2

Character One: An Actress Character Two: A Singing Star

Conflict: The actress and the singing star are invited to attend the event of the season, The A List Awards. When they arrive, they discover they've both been assigned the same seat at the head table, and there's only one seat left. While the actress begins to rant and rave, the singing star flashes her invitation angrily at anyone who'll look, and neither one of them is willing to give up their seat to the other.

Questions for Scenario 1

- 1. Why is the doctor angry?
- 2. What emotions did the businessman bring out in the doctor?
- 3. Was the businessman in the wrong for what he did?
- 4. Did the doctor response appropriately?
- 5. How could the doctor have responded better?
- 6. Do you think the doctor and the businessman could still be friends after this incident?

Questions for Scenario 2

- 1. Are the ladies responsible for this mix-up?
- 2. What seems to be the most important thing to each of the ladies?
- 3. They didn't cause the mix-up, so what's wrong with them reacting this way?
- 4. Do you think others at the event would be embarrassed by their behavior?
- 5. What could be a possible solution to this problem?
- 6. Do you think the actress and the singing star could still be friends after this incident?
