Behavioral Issue:

Does not share school materials with other students

Objective:

• Students will learn to share school materials with other students without being asked to do so.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik
Pens/Pencils/Markers
Scissors/Glue
Construction paper
Magazines/Newspapers
Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, discuss what sharing means to them. Be sure to mention the importance of sharing school materials! Then have each student create their own brochure, describing the different aspects of sharing. Have them sit together...SHARING the materials they'll need.. Have them complete Lilly's sharing sentence. Let them use pictures from magazines or words from the newspaper to fill in the different sections.

Assessment:

Students will recognize the importance of sharing school materials, and building a stronger classroom unit.
