The Toy Store Lesson #6



Behavioral Issue:

Does not participate in classroom activities or special events that are interesting to others

Objective:

• Students will learn to focus on and participate in activities that previously were not of interest to them.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik
Pens/Pencils
Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, discuss some of the many ways someone can experience sharing. Then have everyone fill out the question and comment form. After everyone has had a chance to fill out the form, have the students read them aloud. Over the next week or so, if time allows, do each of these activities together. Have everyone actively participate. Delegate the organization of each activity, making everyone feel important. SHARE the experience!!

Assessment:

Students will learn to share the interests of other classmates through a better understanding of the events that surround the activity.
