Lesson #7



Behavioral Issue:

Does not care for personal appearance

Objective:

- Students will learn the importance of caring for their personal hygiene.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik

Pens/Pencils

Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, discuss how sharing works in many ways. Talk about how people share space. Have the students name the types of places we all have to share. (The classroom, the lunchroom, the playground, an elevator, etc.) Discuss the importance of having a clean appearance and good hygiene, and how it affects the individual's self-esteem, as well as others around them. Afterwards, have the students complete the word search.

Assessment:

Students will understand the importance of good hygiene and will be aware of their own personal appearance.
