Behavioral Issue: Ignores consequences of his/her behavior

Objective:

• Students will consider the consequences of their behavior.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik Pens/Pencils Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, discuss how working together as a unit in a classroom or in the world in general, requires rules. Since we share various environments, we need to respect others and be responsible for our actions. When we break a rule or don't follow directions, we must find a way to make things right. When we're able to accept the consequences for our actions, we take responsibility. This builds good character within ourselves, and it creates healthy relationships with others.
