



Behavioral Issue:

Does not demonstrate appropriate care and handling of other people's property

Objective:

• Students will learn the significance of caring for and handling other people's property with respect.

Materials:

The Toy Store by Julie Woik Pens/Pencils Print out the form that correlates with this lesson

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read The Toy Store. After the reading, talk about the importance of caring for other people's property. Discuss how this is a shared responsibility, as we ALL want our things treated with care and respect. Then hand out the form for this activity. Read the first part of the story aloud. Then have the students create the rest of the story, having them provide answers to help Tommy learn to become more responsible and respectful of other people's property.

Assessment:

Students will take proper care of other people's property.
