Lesson #3



Age:
4th Grade

Objective:

- Students will use writing processes effectively.
- Students will create a written story that contains three main parts.
- Students will be able to identify and add supporting ideas and details to complete their storyline.

Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Print out form that correlates with this lesson.

Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form for this activity. After you've picked names out of the hat...have the students work in teams to create their own "confidence" story. They should write the narrative in which their ideas, the details they want to add, and all of the events are in logical order, and are relevant to the storyline.

Assessment:

Students will draft the narrative by discussing the ideas put forth by the team, recording the thoughts, and putting the ideas in a logical order. They'll edit the document for punctuation and spelling, and then produce the final storyline.
