Art With Heart Lesson #3

Age: 5th Grade



Objective:

- Students will use their listening strategies effectively.
- Students will understand the power of listening.
- Students will provide a thoughtful narrative based on their listening experience.

Materials:

Art With Heart by Julie Woik
Pencils or Pens
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Art With Heart, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, hand out the form for this activity. Ask the students to recall a time in which they listened to something (music, a story, the news). After their listening experience, ask them to write what they learned. Then ask them to write what they thought about what they learned, and what they might do with this information.

Example: Listened: To a song on the radio. Learned: The song made them feel really happy. Think: That they would like to write or play songs too.

Assessment:

Students will recall and breakdown a specific listening experience to help them recognize the importance of using their listening strategies to learn and expand their thinking.
