Age Level: 6 - 10

#### Materials:

Art With Heart book by Julie Woik
7 ½ x 10 Labels (They come on a 8 ½ x 11 size paper.)
Print out Lopsided Louie onto the label sticker paper.
Markers of various colors
Stickers of all sorts, sizes, and colors
Ribbon and String of various colors and sizes
Eyes of various sizes
Buttons and any other crafting supplies
Glue and Scissors



Read Art With Heart together. In this story, we learn that friends can play an important role in supporting and building our confidence. Friends often keep us on track. Good friends will help us make good decisions. Friends who care about us, will tell us the truth and encourage us to be the best we can be. Discuss and truly discover how Pibble's friends helped her recognize her jealousy towards Bellamy, and supported her drawings when she allowed them to take a look.

### Activity:

Everyone needs a friend! In this activity, the child/children get to make a sticker friend for Lopsided Louie. First have everyone draw an outline of their idea of a fun-loving monster on the label sticky paper. After they have the outline, they can add whatever kind of details they may see fit. Using the buttons, various stickers, and other supplies, have the child/children create a wonderful friend for our friend Louie! Oh...don't forget to cut Lopsided Louie out so you can put your friends together.

#### Take Action:

Everyone's monster will be different. Everyone will create a FABULOUS FRIEND who will "stick by Louie" forever. Keep these stickers as a reminder of the value our friends bring to our lives. Take time to think about the friends you have and how they support you!!
