Jungle Jive Lesson #1



Age: 1st Grade

Objective:

- Students will construct meaning from the text, illustrations, and word structure.
- Students will increase comprehension of the story by retelling and discussion.
- Students will use listening strategies effectively.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. After the reading, discuss the details of the story and the essential message intended by the author. Then hand out the form for this activity. Have the students circle the correct words that answer the questions Who, What, Where, When, and Why.

Assessment:

Students will listen for informational purposes, allowing them to retell specific details, including sequence of events in the story. They will be able to identify the story elements of setting, plot, character, problem, and solution.
