Jungle Jive Lesson #4



Age:

1st Grade

Objective:

- Students will understand that most natural events occur in consistent patterns.
- Students will be capable of describing how organisms change as they grow and mature.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. Hand out the form that goes with this activity. Discuss photosynthesis, its importance, and break down the process so it can be easily understood. Perhaps you could bring in a plant, so everyone can take a closer look at the leaves and get up-close and personal with the process that produces oxygen for everyone on the planet!

Assessment:

Students will understand the importance of plant life, the energy they create, and how living things interact with their environment. They will comprehend the sequence of processes that occur during photosynthesis.
