Jungle Jive Lesson #5



Age:
1st Grade

Objective:

- Students will learn to recognize and determine the basic measurement concept of weight.
- Students will effectively use their knowledge of measures to solve problems.

Materials:

Jungle Jive by Julie Woik
Pencils
Print out form that correlates with this lesson.
Optional - Send home letter to parents regarding this lesson.
See attached Letter for Parents

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read Jungle Jive, showing everyone the illustrations. Hand out the form that goes with this activity. Have the children compare the images from the Jungle Jive book, appearing in each box. Ask them to think carefully about the two items, and then circle the one that they believe is heavier in weight than the other. This is a good exercise for children to recognize differences in measurement.

Assessment:

Students will understand a variety of measurement strategies that will help them effectively recognize and describe the differences found in varying objects.
