Age:

4th Grade

Objective:

- Students will understand different ways numbers are represented.
- Students will place-value concepts of grouping based upon powers of ten within the decimal number system.

Materials:

The Kacklin' Kitchen by Julie Woik

Pencils or Pens

Activity:

Gather the children in a circle and read 'The Kacklin' Kitchen, showing everyone the detailed illustrations. After the reading, have the students complete the mathematical problems on the work sheet. Assessment:
