

PowerPoint Presentation for Reading to Children

Sunny Learns About Self-Worth

- Please begin by reviewing the slide show several times, to get familiar with the words, the added movement (animation), and the TIMING of each slide. Using a hand-held clicker to move through the slides, works best. Standing in front of the children, to the left or right of the screen (whichever feels comfortable to you) while presenting...IS KEY! It allows for you to use your enthusiasm, show your facial expressions, point out things, and bring excitement to the room. This will TOTALLY keep the attention of the little ones! I promise!!!
- Slide 1 (Welcome Everyone) can be up on the screen before the children sit down. It's just a fun illustration to get them excited for story time.
- Slide 3 is the introduction of the author and a short description of what an author does regarding books. You can add more information if you like.
- Slide 4 shows the children what book you will be reading.
- Slides 5 to 12 will introduce Lilly the Lash to the children.
- Slide 13 states that the children will be reviewing the characters in the garden. Slides 14 to 23 will be a slide with a question, followed by the answer. Children love shouting the answers!
- Slides 24 to 28 will review the main characters in this book.
- Slides 29 to 61 are the story from beginning to end.
- Slides 62 to 66 provide a quick overview of the story. Slide 62, asks the children a question. Then go to Slide 63, where they can shout out the answer. The same for Slide 64 and 65. Then read Slide 66, explaining that we ALL MATTER.
- Slide 67, you will ask the children if we're all different. And then ask if that's ok? If they answer quietly, cup your hand around your ear and ask the question again...but even louder. If you do that...they WILL respond!! LOL!
- Slide 68, you will ask how are we different. They will respond, and you can help with little suggestions like, "Some people are tall or short or people like to eat different things."
- Slides 69 to 74 are about the value of books and why we want to read. Read each slide, and then review the answers on Slide 74.
- Slides 75 to 77 will bring things to a close.
